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| <p>1) Choose your favourite toy, take them on a journey! Record your trip with photos. You might like to put your photos in a scrapbook or diary and write about what you did.</p> | <p>2) Use old magazines/catalogues find as many pictures of toys as you can and make a collage. How are the toys similar/different? What are they made from? What do they do?</p> | <p>3) Choose a toy and find out about it's history. When and where was it first made?
