As part of our drive to maintain, promote and engage pupil interest in reading, the school is celebrating **World Book Day** on **Thursday 1st March 2018**. We will be beginning a school sponsored Readathon to raise money for the 'Read for Good' charity who provide high quality books and readers to children in hospital. The Readathon will run from Thursday 1st March - Thursday 22nd March⁻ The children will receive a sponsorship form where you can sponsor them 1p for every minute that they read (If you can give more then please do).
